GROWTH 2014/15

2014/15 has been a very positive year for the expanding Growth Team. The number of Fife companies being supported overall by this team increased to 641, with support from our highly professional HR Service Low Carbon Support Programme being in particular demand. Environmental and Energy Reviews provided savings of nearly £300,000 to over 60 businesses who engaged with our Low Carbon Adviser.

In order to meet the rising demand for the services of the Growth Team, we have increased our number of advisers, all of whom have owned their own businesses and have a raft of relevant experience from a diverse range of industries and public/private sectors. Offering a personal and professional attitude to supporting growing companies

in Fife, several supported companies achieved significant success in the Fife Business Awards, Scottish Edge Fund and Courier Business Awards.

Specific support intervention for high street retailers has been provided through the Town Centre Business Support Fund, with 63 businesses benefitting from the Vacant Property Grant and/or the Business Improvement Grant.

The Fife Investment Fund and the East of Scotland Investment Fund supported 134 established companies in providing financial support towards a wide range of projects and developments.

Our network of Approved Suppliers provided 55 companies with direct relevant Expert Help support, which ranged from IT consultants, accountants, lawyers, HR professionals and web developers to online marketing experts.

START-UP BUSINESSES 2014/15

The Start-Up Team provides support to individuals aiming to develop an idea into a business and to evolve these into trading status. With over 35 appointments available each week, our Advisers offer 1:1 meetings in Dunfermline, Kirkcaldy, Glenrothes and Cupar to meet demand. Working with clients on business planning, financial forecasting, market research and signposting, the Start-Up Team are crucial to the early stages of self-employment. Encouraging attendance at courses in our training centres and providing relevant personal experience, all provides an accelerated start for aspiring business owners.

Through providing tailored support and events, including our highly successful 'Just Start It' series, which attracted over 70 attendees at three locations, the Start-Up Team helped a remarkable 801 businesses start-up in Fife.



HIGH VALUE START-UP 2014/15

Business Gateway Fife recognises the importance of tailoring the support that it offers to clients. Accordingly, those start-up clients who have the potential to achieve significant growth in the early stages of their business, have access to our dedicated High Value Start-Up adviser. Clients in this category are defined as those looking to achieve a minimum turnover of £70,000, plus employ staff and/ or work from business premises. Our dedicated High Value Start-Up Adviser works with these clients to assist with business development; to implement the most appropriate support plan to facilitate the business growth required and to signpost clients to relevant experts where necessary.

In 2014/15, 74 businesses benefited from this specific support. In addition to the extensive range of services available to all clients, high value start-ups may also benefit from a grant of up to £2,000 (50% match funding of eligible costs), and access a financial contribution for professional consultancy services to support specific areas of business development.

I went to Business Gateway Fife for advice on patenting, exporting and traceability. We are now in discussion with three potential suppliers ready to take the product to market in the UK and Eire and there has also been interest from as far afield as Singapore, Australia and the UAE.

WORKSHOPS/SEMINARS

Throughout 2014/15, events continue to be an integral part of the services provided by Business Gateway Fife. This key service is a resource that many individuals and business owners use and value, with customer satisfaction levels sitting at 90%, which is extremely positive and encouraging.

With topics to suit everyone – from pre-start introductory sessions to more skills based sessions including finance, marketing, project management and social media, we've delivered over 200 events that provide key skills to anyone in business, and the great thing is, they are all free!

We work with a number of professional training providers and partner organisations to deliver our events, some of which are created on an ad-hoc basis to meet demand and suit what is

happening in the local economy. One of these specialist events was our 'Just Start It' Event which ran in February and enabled attendees to hear first-hand from local business owners including; Love Restored; Arro Lighting & Events; Eden Legal and Jannettas Gelateria. Our 'Meet the Funder' event brought together a range of funding providers so Fife businesses could find out what financial support was available to them. We also focused on Digital Marketing and created some new titles including; Advertising on Facebook; Email Marketing and Content Marketing.

With 81% of our 1507 attendees happy to recommend Business Gateway Events to others, we still aim, year on year, to continually improve the quality and variety of events on offer and adapt to our customer requirements.



Aimed at individuals and businesses who have recently started trading within the last 24 months. Loan amounts are determined on the needs of the business - average loan size around £6,000. 6% interest rate applied.



Prince's Trust, Enterprise Programme

Providing targeted support to young people interested in entrepreneurship, the programme supports 18 to 30 year olds to start-up and continue in business by providing essential funding and professional mentoring support.

Assisting businesses to exhibit at trade

vessels operating from the Anstruther District and businesses operating in the production, processing & marketing of seafood products in Fife. Up to 50% grant contribution available, up to a maximum of £5000.
